

2018-2019 32nd Annual Young Artist Competition

Entry Information

Entry fee: \$45.00

Entrants' ages as of November 19, 2018:

Junior Division - through age 13

Senior Division - age 14 -18

Entrants will send an audition recording of not more than 15 minutes playing time. The recording should be of the best quality possible. Accompaniment is preferred, but not required. The work performed must have orchestral accompaniment and must be the same work that the candidate will play with the orchestra if selected. **Cuts may be made to the accompaniment in order to stay within the time limit, but cuts to the solo part are not permitted.**

Compact disc or DVD recording and a non-returnable photocopy of the music (solo part only) are to be sent with the entry form and \$45.00 fee to New World, postmarked no later than November 19, 2018. Finalists will be notified the week of December 3, 2018. No preference is given to either a CD or DVD application. Applicants should strive to submit a format with the very highest quality of **audio**.

Final auditions will be Saturday, January 5, 2019 at the Indiana History Center in Indianapolis. All final auditions must be performed from memory. Applicants must provide their own accompanists. Winners will be notified following the final auditions.

Past winners are requested not to re-enter consecutive years on the same instrument.

Tentatively, the Junior Winner will perform with the New World Youth Symphony Orchestra on Sunday, February 17, 2019, at Hilbert Circle Theatre. The Senior Winner will perform with the New World Youth Symphony Orchestra on Sunday, May 12, 2019, at Hilbert Circle Theatre.

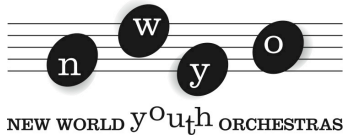

Judging and Awards

Note: To be considered, concerti or other appropriate solo works (instrumental, piano, or vocal) must be compatible with the New World Youth Symphony Orchestra's instrumentation and performing capabilities.

Judging: An independent panel of judges will select one of the qualified finalists in each division to solo with the orchestra. The panel reserves the right to declare no winner.

Awards: The winner will receive a CD or DVD of the performance with the Orchestra. An honorarium will be presented to the winners in each division:

\$450.00 in the Senior Division

\$225.00 in the Junior Division

\$100.00 Second place winners for the Senior and Junior Divisions

\$50.00 Third place winners for the Senior and Junior Divisions

The Young Artist Competition is a highlight of the New World season as an opportunity to engage the talents of young musicians from around the state of Indiana. The competition features two divisions, the Senior Division, which includes ages fourteen through eighteen, and the Junior Division, which includes musicians through the age of thirteen.

Vocalists and instrumentalists must apply by the **November 19, 2018** postmark deadline. Preliminary judging of audition tapes will begin immediately following the deadline to determine the finalists selected to perform a live audition on January 5, 2019.

Judges for the live final round include distinguished professional musicians, as well as college music educators, representing a variety of experience in instrumental and vocal music. One soloist from each division (Junior and Senior) will be selected to perform with the New World Youth **Symphony** Orchestra. Winners will also receive a cash prize.

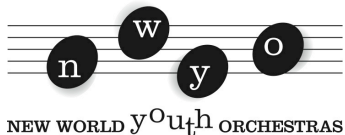
